Come Play Dogwood G.C.'s Family/Forward Tees

- In partnership with the PGA of America, the U.S. Kids Golf Forward Tees setup helps young golfers and beginners play from appropriate yardages.
- The benefits include: Kids and all members of the family play faster and not feel rushed.
- Lower scores and more fun

Forward Tees add two levels of tees to each hole well in front of the existing tees. Teeing grounds are marked by placing a tee plate on level locations in the fairway. In addition, a smaller locator tee is placed near the cart path to indicate where to find the Forward Tee marker in the fairway. The forward most tees on most golf courses are approximately 2,500 yards for nine holes, which is too long for young players and adult beginners. By adding two sets of tee locations (Level 1 - approx. 1,500 yards for nine holes, Level 2 - approx. 2,000 yards for nine holes) all family members are able to enjoy their round.



PGA Jr. League

Is a game-changing opportunity for boys and girls 13 years old and under to learn and play golf. The program brings family and friends together around fun, team golf experiences with expert coaching from PGA and LPGA Professionals. PGA Jr. League is all about the recreational and developmental nature of regular season matches.

Format & Rules During the course of one game, teams play four 9-hole matches in a popular two-person scramble format, reinforcing the team concept and creating a nurturing environment for learning the game. Coaches can also substitute players every three holes, so that all of the golfers on each team can participate.

PGA professionals know that three basic components are critical to the learning process: Fitted Equipment, A structured learning program, Organized competition.

Besides having properly fitted equipment and tournaments, U.S. Kids Golf developed a kid-friendly learning program. The [Learning Program booklets](#) are used by PGA professionals throughout the country and internationally. It features three levels of learning, each one progressively building on the other. Skills and correct forms are taught in **putting, chipping, pitching, bunkers, and full swing**. A **playing ability test** is included, along with sections on rules and etiquette. Incentive pins are earned, and progress can be measured. Once each level is completed, the young golfers move on to the next level. Kids, their parents, and their golf instructor all work from the same point of reference.

The U.S. Kids Golf Learning Program is a proven method to introduce golf to young players. The program becomes more difficult as players advance through each of the three levels, and the Level 1, 2 and 3 booklets provide the framework for both coaches and parents.
