

Rain Check Policy

- Rain checks will be issued when it is determined the course is unfit for play or when players are in danger of lightning strike.
- Players must bring their receipt to the pro shop in order to receive a rain check.
- Rain checks will be issued for 18 holes if less than 4 holes are completed. A 9 hole rain check will be issued if more than 4 holes and less than 12 holes. More than 12 holes conclude a round.
- Cash will not be refunded: only a credit will be issued.
- Any player starting their round in the rain will not be issued a rain check.
- Rain checks are not issued due to slow play.

Course Ambassadors

- Ambassadors are player assistants. They are here to ensure all players have an enjoyable round of golf at a proper pace of play and according to golf rules.
- Ambassadors on duty will have the authority to enforce pace of play as well as the club's regulations. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- Slow play and cart path violations will be brought to your attention.
- Not repairing divots or ball marks will be brought to your attention.

Clubhouse Policy

- Clubhouse hours are determined by the season and will change periodically.
- Proper dress code required in the clubhouse (see dress code). Denim is allowed in the clubhouse provided they are not with holes, shredded or cut-off. Work denim is not allowed.
- No outside alcoholic beverages are to be brought into the clubhouse or on the premises. DWGC reserves the right to confiscate any alcoholic beverages brought onto premises.
- DWGC expects proper behavior from all members and their guests. Members will be held responsible for the behavior and proper dress of their guests.
- DWGC will exercise every reasonable care for the property of the members, but will not be responsible for any type of damage or loss.

Please note that DWGC reserves the right to make changes to the policies and rules and regulations set in place at any time without notification.

The following rules are designed to make your membership at Dogwood Golf Club a great experience by not only communicating what is expected but also allowing the Dogwood Golf Club staff to better serve our members and guests.

COURSE RULES & REGULATIONS

General Golf Rules

- Rules and regulations apply to all members, guests and public players
- All Golfers including Walkers, MUST ALWAYS CHECK IN at the Pro Shop prior to play and obtain a valid receipt.
- Jumping out on the course without checking in will not be tolerated. This also applies to any player deciding to play extra holes. You must check in at Pro Shop.
- Unless otherwise informed by a Club Official, ALL Play begins on #1 Tee Box.
- No more than four players per group. NO five-somes or more allowed.
- Please replace ALL Divots and Repair ball marks.
- Proper Golf attire must be worn. (see Dress Code)
- ALL alcoholic beverages must be purchased from the DW Grill and we reserve the right to check all coolers at anytime.
- Loud, vulgar and abusive behavior will not be tolerated on the course or in the clubhouse.
- Throwing of clubs will not be tolerated and will result in suspension.
- Please keep a proper pace of play as outlined on the Scorecards. Slower players must allow faster players to play through if they have fallen more than one hole behind the group in front of them.

- Take advantage of the Grills “Quick Turn Menu” so that your position on the course is not jeopardized.
- Play one ball only. Please use the designated practice areas for practicing.
- Please use proper etiquette at all times. See GSGA Golf Etiquette 101 for more details.
- A typical 18 hole round is an estimated 4 hours.
- All members must always show respect to fellow members and to Dogwood staff.

Golf Cart Regulations

- Carts will be mandatory on weekends before 12 noon and for all member tournaments.
- Maximum of two persons per cart.
- Operator must be at least 16 years of age with valid drivers license.
- Carts must remain on all cart paths unless the 90 degree rule is in effect.
- 90 Degree Rule – Carts may leave cart path and go 90 degrees across fairway to play shot, but must return to cart path.
- Carts are prohibited within 40 yards of the Green
Please obey Course markings
- Operators are responsible for any damage to carts due to misuse.

- Pull Carts are NOT permitted on the Fringe of the Greens.
- Carts are to remain on the cart path at Tee Box Areas.

Dress Code

- Men: Men must wear collared shirt, slacks or golf shorts. Jeans, tank tops, t-shirts, cut-offs or gym shorts are not permitted
- Ladies: Ladies must wear golf designed dresses , blouses, golf tops, golf shorts & skirts. Jeans, halter tops, t-shirts, cut-offs or gym shorts.
- Shoes: Golf designed shoes required. Soft spike policy is in affect.
- Members are responsible for informing your guests of the dress code.

Handicapping

- All handicaps will be kept according to the GSGA handicapping system.
- Scores must be entered after every round.
- Members are responsible for entering their adjusted score.
- Handicap Fee is \$32 for members and \$40 for non-members.
- All tournament scores will be tagged as a tournament round.
